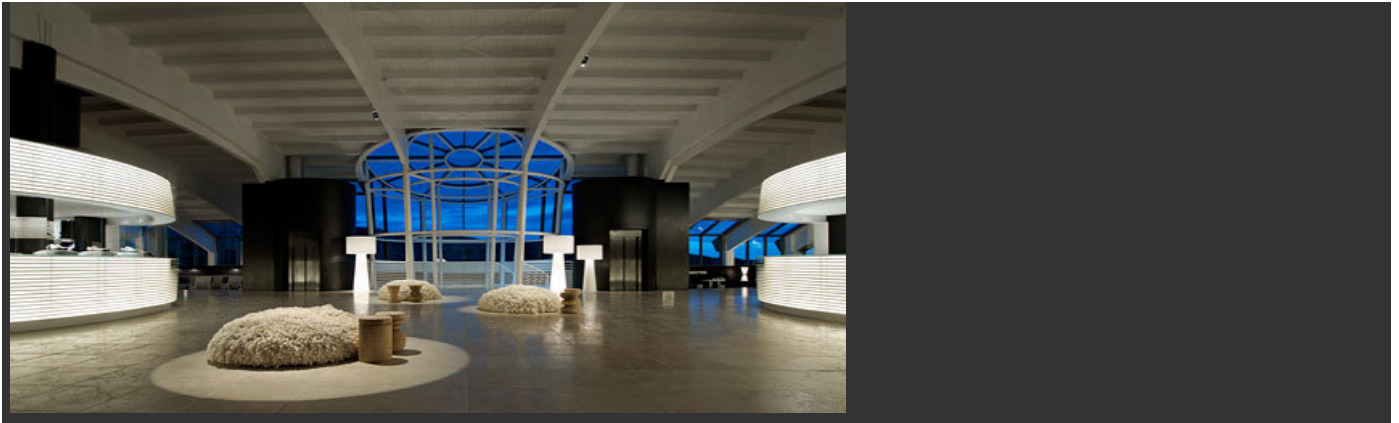


# ARGENTARIO GOLF RESORT & SPA



A luxury resort, designed by designer Andrea Fogli, that has 56 junior suites all endowed with terraces on the Golf field, with every comfort and with the last technologies. The suites are divided into three levels each one characterized by a different style. The CLUB Junior Suites represent the more glamour spirit of the resort. Dark woods, tubs in tabarca stone to the center of the room, warm colors and precious plotted which characterize the international vocation.

The TUSCANY Junior Suite with black furnish in contrast with the oak floor, the black woodworks and the great tub in “serena” stone, make these rooms the warmest of the resort. The GALLERY Junior Suites define a new contemporaneity already when you walk through the corridor viewed as expotional space. White “ resina”, optical contrasts, vintage furnishes and contemporary photos are the answer by AGR&S to the common conception of resort.

Completely surrounded by nature with a view of the golf course, the wellness center Espace is waiting to relax you under the starry sky of the turkish aroma bath, steam bath thalasso, Finnish sauna, emotional showers, relax area, indoor pool and outdoor heated panoramic views, positions whirlpool, saltwater pool, outdoor pools, solarium with views of hole 18, tecnogym equipped gym, massage and treatment cabins. ## GOLF



The Argentario Golf Club is situated in a protected oasis surrounded by Mediterranean vegetation, in which every hole is different from the other, offering unique and extraordinary scenery. Surrounded by cork forests and centenary olive trees, hares, squirrels and deer, one can admire an amazing and pure environment. Maremma's beautiful slopes, the sea and the lagoon, emerged in the scent of strawberry trees, set the scene of a unique environment with a mild climate that allows golf to be played all year long. The eighteen-hole golf course was designed by architect David Mezzacane, with the extraordinary collaboration of Baldovino Dassù. The greens are almost all small, with a light breeze that contributes to a mild temperature and adds a variable to the game, which on this course requires both precision and strength. The entire area, including the grass of the course, is certified "Agri Cert" eco bio compatible and everything used to maintain it is absolutely natural.

## **WHERE WE ARE**

The Argentario Golf Resort & Spa is located in the Maremma Region, one of the most enchanting areas in Tuscany, on the Mount Argentario and only few minutes away from Porto Ercole, Orbetello and the beautiful sandy beaches named Feniglia and Giannella. From here you can reach the centre of Rome in less than 90 minutes, the Rome Fiumicino airport and the city of Siena in about 60 minutes and the centre of Florence in fewer than 2 hours.

Coming by train the nearest station is Orbetello, while the nearest airport is Rome Fiumicino.

### **Driving direction from the airport of Rome Fiumicino:**

Continue along Via Mario De Bernardi towards “Grande Raccordo Anulare; Roma; Autostrade”

Continue along the A91

Continue along the A12/E80

Continue along the SS1/E80 towards GROSSETO

Continue along the SP161

Pass by Orbetello Scalo and Orbetello

Once you arrive at the Stop to go direction Porto Ercole, drive along and turn right following the indication to the ARGENTARIO GOLF CLUB

### **Arriving from the north (Milan):**

Continue along: Raccordo per l’Autostrada del Sole; Head towards “Tangenziale

Ovest/E35/BOLOGNA/MALPENSA

Continue along the A1; Head towards: E31/LA SPEZIA/PARMA OVEST

Continue along the A15/E33, Towards: GENOVA/LIVORNO

Continue along the A127E80; Head Towards: ROMA/PIOMBINO/SARDEGNA/ISOLA D’ELBA/CECINA/SS206/VADA

Continue along the SS1/E80

Pass “Fiume Albegna”; Take SS1/E80/VIA AURELIA NORD; Turn right; Exit Fiume Albegna

Continue along the SP36; Pass by Saline Sadun

Turn right: SS440/SP161

Once you arrive at the Stop to go direction Porto Ercole, drive along and turn right following the indication to the ARGENTARIO GOLF CLUB
